# Road Race Panel Delegate Report

- Further discussion around rider grading.
  - All riders promoted from D Grade to C Grade at the end of first year racing
  - C Grade to B Grade promotion to be based on riding within -5% of club/state level lap record i.
    e sub 1:15's at Mallala/Mac Park. Will be reviewed based on consistency and race craft.
  - A Grade to be reserved for those winning State Championships, competing at National level, combined with rider conduct and presentation as a representative of the sport and state.
- Minimum requirements for State Championship rounds to be discussed and settled on going forwards. This will be set by the Road Race Panel but is expected to be a minimum requirement of two qualifiers and three races.
- Review of State Championship Classes expectation is moving towards alignment to ASBK Classes. Other classes remaining is subject to continued class entries meeting the minimum requirements to sustain class as a State Championship class.
- Expressions of interest are now open for the 2023 bLU cRU Junior Cup Championships –
