

What worked well...

- Prizegiving / Presentation BBQ
- Assistance with event "tear down" post racing on Sunday lots of people chipping in/asking/offering to help out.

- TBMP supplying radios & headsets and arranging drop off/return each day.
- Pit entry/exit on 2 Hour Races was really good.

### East Circuit – Race Meeting Debrief

What didn't work well/needs improving...

- Turnaround time between races took too long riders not ready / 5 min call could be tighter.
- Not having 2 minute call
- Not having a PA that everyone could hear
- Designation of CAFNIX members in Computime data only confirmed on the day too late
- Scrutineering could/should have been done on Friday for racers.
- Sign on sheets & scrutineering sheets not ready prior to Saturday sign in staff not fully briefed on requirements in advance
- Assistance with Flaggies eskies in the mornings shouldn't fall to one person to organize.
- Differing instructions between supp regs/final instructions on pit setup for Endurance Races
- Running endurance races on a State Championship weekend.
- Riders taking their time on the out lap long circuit need to get to startline ASAP
- Communication with TBMP staff regarding wrist bands & payment availability
- Radio Comms didn't find out/work out til Sunday that we had issues with comms, resolved by changing to
  a different frequency/band then it worked flawlessly.
- Double entries in Reece Bancell / Steve Martin also non eligible machines entered.
- Miscommunication regarding Trophies only CAFNIX Trophies asked for made.
- Not using of course car in Lightweight 2hr to allow bike/rider return to pits.

#### **General Business**

- Need to get more people onboard at Level 1 Officials via MSA/Ridernet online course to get test done, approx. 1hr, followed by in person 2 Hour session at MSA
- Rolling grids?
